ALL RECYCLING BINS MUST BE KEPT INSIDE IN DRY PLACE

**ANY SCHEDULED PICK UP DAYS ON A HOLIDAY AND DAYS FOLLOWING A HOLIDAY WILL RUN ONE DAY LATE!**

WE WILL NOT PICK UP ANYTHING OVER 35 POUNDS AND YOU CAN USE UP TO 33 GALLON SIZE GARBAGE BAGS

Not acceptable: mirrors, ceramic cups and plates, clay flower pots, crystal, light bulbs, window glass, heat resistant ovenware, drinking glasses</p>	<p><b>PLASTIC</b> <b>CONTAINERS MUST HAVE</b> <b>RECYCLING SYMBOL</b></p>  <p>PLASTICS 1 THROUGH 7 PLASTIC BAGS ARE NOT RECYCLABLE Items which can be tied together (such as milk cartons) may be placed next to bin.
